The post-doctoral fellow will join the team of the Research School of International Taxation (RSIT, <https://www.rsit-uni-tuebingen.de/>). The RSIT is an interdisciplinary group of leading scholars from the Universities of Tübingen, Eichstätt-Ingolstadt, Köln, Mannheim and Münster, analysing current issues in international taxation. All affiliated scholars are exceptionally well integrated into numerous national and international research networks.

We are seeking candidates with strong skills in applied microeconomics and applied econometrics who hold a doctorate degree (or are very close to completion). Ideal candidates have research interests in one or more of the following areas: International Taxation, Multinational Firms, Tax Policy, Income Taxation. The appointees will closely collaborate with junior and senior researchers and will be encouraged to pursue her own research agenda. They are expected to actively participate in the activities of the RSIT.

Each appointment will be for an initial period of four years with the possibility of renewal for further two years. Successful candidates will enjoy a reduced teaching load.

The RSIT is committed to the promotion and support of early-career researchers and offers a vibrant research environment. Together with the Department of Economics, we run multiple weekly seminar series and the RSIT regularly organizes workshops and conferences. The post-doctoral researcher will have exclusive access to a range of important datasets to conduct research in the area of international/public economics and taxation.
